

Head Lice Policy



If we discover that a child has head lice we would display a note in the window to inform all the parents, we would also like to inform the parent of the child concerned and advise them to treat the head lice. We would provide a leaflet if requested.

If it was not successfully treated after a period of time then we would advise the parent that perhaps it would be best to keep the child at home until he/she is completely free of lice. This procedure would only be followed in extreme circumstances.

If a family member desperately needs our support with clearing the head lice due to circumstances at home, we could ask the parent for written permission to use the conditioner and a head lice comb whilst the child was at playgroup.
